

Patton launches Contactless Safe Wash Station to combat COVID-19

The product is hands-free, foot-operated, compact, strong, and durable. Easy to operate and maintain, it is suitable for residential, commercial, industrial, medical, and public spaces.

After testing multiple prototypes, two variations of the first model were launched - the Regular Single Basin (200 Litre Tank Capacity) and the Ultra Single Basin (500 Litre Tank Capacity).

The overwhelmingly positive response to these and further R&D led to the design of a second model that is a sanitisation must-have for places with high footfall. Designed with both safe & efficient handwashing in mind, this model - Contactless Safe Wash Station 2.0 Deluxe Dual - has two foldable

basins that allow for two people to safely and simultaneously wash their hands.

For all models, the 200-litre tank allows for up to 300 hand washes per refill while the 500-litre tank allows for up to 750 hand washes per refill. Available in black, blue, and green, the water tanks are made of 100% virgin food-grade plastic. The stand on which the tank is placed is made of powder coated metal, making it rust-proof.

These unique products are not only easy to assemble, transport, maintain, but also have a sleek compact design that make it space-saving too. They are manufactured, pre-assembled, quality checked, transported, and installed on-site by Patton. A complimentary antimicrobial liquid soap approved by the FSSAI (Food Safety & Standards Authority of India) allows the customer to start using the product immediately.
